8J. Juniors (A – 12 and under) (B – 18 and under)

1. Best decorated pumpkin or squash, any size, not carved
2. Most Unusual Shaped Fruit or Vegetable
3. Carved Pumpkin
4. Longest zucchini
5. Tomatoes, any colour, stems on, 5
6. Carrots, tops trimmed, 5
7. Best Quality Sunflower head
8. 3 or 4 litre decorated basket with 6 or more different fruit or vegetables neatly arranged.

Rules & Regulations

1. \$8.00 constitutes membership and the right to make entries.
2. Junior categories are aged 18 and under, unless otherwise stated. Adult categories are aged 19 and above.

Juniors entering an Adult/Open Class **MUST** purchase a membership.

3. All fruits, flowers, vegetable and farm produce products must be the property of the exhibitor, grown in the present year and of his/her own farm or holding.
4. No single entry will be allowed to be exhibited for two different prizes.
5. Exhibitors will be entitled to only one entry, per class, per section.
6. All exhibits in the Homecraft Departments must be owned and made within the previous twenty-four months by the exhibitor.
7. All exhibits are to be uploaded from September 24-26 on <https://www.assistexpo.ca/ilderton-ag-society>.
8. Judges have full power to place articles in their proper classes and to withhold prize money on account of inferiority.
9. **THE JUDGE'S DECISION IS FINAL.**
10. The following year's membership will be deducted from all prize winnings of \$9.00 or more.
